This year particularly, our team focusses on creating a practical, implementable program that can be replicated across our all projects. Highlight of this year was that our projects include program which provide fun, absorbing and challenging learning experience that children eagerly look forward to 2018-2019 has been a particularly special year for MIMA. Not just because we were bringing positive changes but also because we were able to give so many children the chance to discover their true potential.

The year 2018-19 was as much a year of continuation as it was of beginnings. Through our core programmes we continued to provide quality education to underprivileged children residing in slum. We also entered into new partnerships with institutions and organisations who share our vision which until now was confined to community settings.

We believe that children have better adult outcomes if empowered on a number of fronts, specifically emotional, life skills, learning, qualifications and work readiness. Keeping this in mind, we have started new projects this year to reach more underprivileged children. We have started new project “shashakt” under which street classes are organised and mobilisation of volunteers has been done.

# WHAT WE DO

## OVERVIEW

Mera India Mera Adhikar is a Registered Non- Government Organisation(Regd). Our work is concentrated on 3 main Fundamental RIGHTS i.e **Right to Education, Right to Equality and Right against exploitation**. Which we believe are the areas of greatest need and deserve to be the focus of our attention.

We believe the three are inter-related fields and together the only way to make a sustainable and impactful difference in the beneficiary population. We work for the upliftment of the poor and destitute by helping them achieve socio-economic independence, self-sustainability and health. We do everything from providing educational services to the needy, mainstreaming marginalized street children, making low-literate youth employable and empowering women. We help those in need with full respect, love and commitment, with the aim to not deliver charity but to empower them to better their own lot.

MIMA is **the full-spectrum grassroots NGO in Delhi**, providing services spanning the development of Education, and equality and thus able to provide a comprehensive path from poverty to prosperity and fully empower the destitute to tread it successfully.

## Right to Education

- We provide tuition classes in which around 100 students get benefited. Classes starts from 2nd to 9th class .Which are separated in different classes at different time according to their classes. In which there is batches of around 20 students.
- Test of each class is taken on every month and the results are shown to their parents.
- Parents teacher meeting is also organised so that parents also got information of progress so that they can think much positive about their kid's future. And can encourage them.
- Provide English classes to the youth of the slum who wanted to groom their life so that they can compete with this highly competitive world. Beside their

regular job they free themselves to take English classes. Around 25 young guys are get benefited through " English class".

## **RIGHT TO EQUALITY:**

Extra curriculum activities invite an open ground to present talents and enhance it. We work with children's and families to help them discover their inner ability that could be a skill to sustain them in this world of competition. We steadily organize extra curriculum activities to motivate the slum-dweller to create an environment for them to open up and share the good that they cherish through these activities.

### **The objectives of the program being:**

To promote educational, cultural and social interest among families and children from disadvantaged society, various schools and communities to provide a platform to the underprivileged children to express their hidden talents and creativity. We encourage them by giving away prizes on their performance and try to provide much better platform for them.

# PROJECTS

## 1. PROJECT ENLIGHTENMENT

Project enlightenment was started in 2013 with objective of providing quality education to underprivileged children over a period of time, ensuring empowerment to them so that they will be able to face challenges with iron hand.

It also aimed to provide classes with unique style where various activities as well as props are used to make study interesting. It also aimed to make children excel in Maths, English and Hindi.

This year was an interesting year where many creative ways was used to make studying interesting and new activities were carried out.

Under this project as well as library has also been expanded so that children have access to quality resources.



### Achievements

- 50+ students were enrolled
- 30 students got rank in their respective classes.
- 300+ children were benefitted.
- 2500+ books were collected for the library and distribution.

## 2. ARTSHALA

Project Artshala was started in 2017 with aim to enhance creativity level of children as we believe that every child is unique and have potential which is different from each other. It aims overdevelopment of children by enhancing:

- 1) Creativity level
2. Leadership qualities
3. Performance
4. Increasing general awareness

Project includes different activities like debate, spellathon, drawing, logothon and cooking without fire. Under this project, we conduct creative activities as per our motto of "learning by doing", every Saturday is selected for conducting activities.

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### Achievements

- 100 children are benefitted
- Cooking without fire activities were organized by youth club
- Debates were organized on various topics.
- Drawing session were conducted.
- Students participated in NAVODUIT program in which different activities were organized. Out of 14 activities conducted, our children were able to secure prizes in 5 activities.
- Decoration of Diyas and candles were done by kids.

It is project which is added this year so as to connect and to increase our reach in providing basic education. In this project, we provide Sunday classes to children where different activities are used as medium for teaching. This project is purely volunteer based who are basically from different colleges and institutions.

This year, our street classes started in malai mandir camp where as planned every Sunday different activities are conducted which in turn help children to learn and develop them.

### **3. SHASHAKT**



#### **Achievements**

- 20 students were enrolled.
- 15 volunteers were engaged for different activities.
- Distribution of stationery to children.
- Moral values session were conducted.
- Nukkadnatak was organized to sensitise people about cleanliness importance.

This project was small initiative taken by us previous year with aim to engage more students with us and win their trust. last year we find that football is great medium to divert children from bad habits and engage them in other productive activities.

Under this project we conduct training session on every Sunday and public holidays. Training session is conducted by our volunteers who have football background and are from different colleges. We also give them match practices as well as register them for football matches.

This year we connect more children and one of the biggest achievement was that some girls were also engaged.

## 4. Novoday



### Achievements

- Able to divert children towards right path from wrong path.
- 20 girls and boys were connected.
- Football equipment were provided to them.
- 5 matches played during this year in TFL ,HT GIFA etc.
- Inspirational videos related to football were shown to children.

## 5. Youth ki awaaz

It is one of the innovative projects which was started in 2017 with objective of building leadership quality, boost confidence level of children and sensitise them on social issues which is happening around them. It also aims at building future leaders and create chain of network.

Under this project, youth club has been formed in which 11 member team is formed. They organize different activities for their juniors and classmates. This year also new 11 children were elected and were trained by volunteers and members to harness their qualities.

Taosif is child who left his school and hometown at class 4 due to financials problem to become bread-earner and came to Delhi. He was working in shop of sector 12 r.k. puram and has no interest in studies. When one day he came to MIMA centre for English class. He was inspired and was able to understand the value of education. He started coming to MIMA English classes regularly after his job. He was enrolled in National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) through MIMA and now he has cleared 10<sup>th</sup> exam with 1<sup>st</sup> division i.e. 61%.

He has also become our volunteer and is very motivated. He believes that no one is too small to help, if you want you can help whenever, you just need will and want to complete his further studies.

MUSKAAN is a 12yr old Girl of class 7<sup>th</sup> of a government school. Her mother is a maid and her father is a plumber. Initially when she joined M.I.M.A, she has difficulties in reading, writing, and doing basic maths problems. She was very shy girl with lack of confidence. With the help of our volunteers and teachers now she had improved a lot and she is now among the toppers in her class. She enthusiastically participates in various
