What We Do

We do everything from providing educational services to the needy, mainstreaming marginalized street children, making low-literate youth employable and empowering women. We help those in need with full respect, love and commitment, with the aim to not deliver charity but to empower them to better their own lot.

MIMA is the full-spectrum grassroots NGO in Delhi, providing services spanning the development of Education, and equality and thus able to provide a comprehensive path from poverty to prosperity and fully empower the destitute to tread it successfully.

Right to Education

- We provide tuition classes in which around 100 students get benefited. Classes starts from 2nd to 9th class. Which are separated in different classes at different time according to their classes. In which there is batches of around 20 students.
- Test of each class is taken on every month and the results are shown to their parents.

- Parent teacher meeting is also organised so that parents also got information of progress so that they can think much positive about their kid's future. And can encourage them.
- Provide English classes to the youth of the slum who wanted to groom their life so that they can compete in today's highly competitive world. Besides their regular job they free themselves to take English classes. Around 25 young guys are get benefited through "English class".

Right to Equality

Extra curriculum activities invite an open ground to present talents and enhance it. We work with children's and families to help them discover their inner ability that could be a skill to sustain them in this world of competition. We steadily organize extra curriculum activities to motivate the slum-dweller to create an environment for them to open up and share the good that they cherish through these activities.**Following activities were conducted to promote awareness in various vital**

The objectives of the program being

To promote educational, cultural and social interest among families and children from disadvantaged society, various schools and communities to provide a platform to the underprivileged children to express their hidden talents and creativity. We encourage them by giving away prizes on their performance and try to provide much better platform for them.

PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

PROJECT ENLIGHTENMENT

Currently, there is a dearth of adequate quality education at an affordable cost for the poor and needy. This lack of quality education impairs people belonging to such groups in a negative manner for their entire life. Thus, this gave rise to Project ENLIGHTENMENT which began with the aim to provide quality education to the poor and needy and along this journey an upliftment and betterment of their life as a whole.

It aims to provide classes with unique style where various activities as well as props are used to make study interesting. It also aims to make children excel in Maths, English and Hindi.

This past year saw Project ENLIGHTENMENT growing at a fast pace not only because of our increased volunteer workforce or manhours spent but also because of the increased partnerships with other NGOs that we were able to do during this past year.

PROJECT ARTSHALA

It is evident from the New Education Policy 2020 that rote memorization techniques are now going to take a backtrack in the student's learning process. Rather the new education vision that we also wish to inculcate in our NGO and its students is the enhanced focus on creativity and social learning.

Our vision to provide children with an environment and space where they can be as creative as they desire without any judgement or fear of grading led us to the development of Project ARTSHALA. This project aims to enable student learning through inclusion of creativity and artwork in the form of various activities.

This year NGO member and volunteers were tasked with the objective to come up with and develop new ideas and activities that could be used as a part of this project and also ensured active student participation and enjoyment.



- Improving pedagogy to inculcate objective and outcome-based learning.
- Various idea generation workshops held with our volunteers.
- Introduced sessions such as Spellathon, Logothon, Movies on projector, Debates, Motivational short videos, etc. aimed at developing emotional maturity among children.

SHASHAKT

This project was introduced in the last year with the aim to increase our reach and connect in providing basic education.

We provide Sunday classes to children where we use various activities as a medium for teaching. This project is purely volunteer based who are from different institutions having a diverse background.

This year we increased our reach even further leading to a new place in Sector 9 for activities. We increased the number of volunteers contributing to this project as well as motivated many local people to be engaged with us.

PROJECT NAVODAY

Project Navodaya was started in 2017 with the vision to bring children closer to education by using football as a medium. This programme was started so that more students can join and be benefit from MIMA.

Football is a good sport and a great medium through which children can be attracted towards education and can be used to divert children from bad habits. With this project, our main objective is to inculcate productive habits and leadership skills in children while keeping them away from wasteful activities.

Every Sunday training sessions were held which not only focused on the game but also the all-round development of body and soul. Students were encouraged to take up leadership roles and were taught to respect the game, the rules and the fellow players.

This year we got an overwhelming response and we observed an increase in participation by girls.



- An overwhelming response from students. More than 50 students participated.
- We received encouragement and footballs from sports organizations.
- Participation of girls increased this time; 3 girls also got a chance to attend the leadership summit organized by G4G.
- More than 10 tournaments were played at major events.

Youth Club

MIMA has started youth club where young leaders are nurture for future. All interactions are from and for the youth.

Our aim with the youth club is to inculcate leadership qualities among students of all ages and to improve their productivity and confidence.

The youth club consisting of 11 children is involved in events such as the Artshala, Summer camps, Diwali and Christmas celebrations, etc.



Other events organized by the Youth club are to educate children about good and bad habits, sessions about moral values, Teacher's Day celebrations.
